## PEF Summary



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### What is PEF?

Pupil Equity Funding is a sum of money designated to support children who experience barriers to learning. The Scottish Government requires us to use the fund to close the 'poverty related attainment gap'.

### How much PEF money do we receive at St. Mary's PS?

Our allocation is currently £76,680 per year.

### Other Key Activities to Assist a Culture of Equity:

- \* Participation in WLC Leading Equitable Schools programme
- \* Participation in Inclusion Support Model intervention and use of Circle / Inclusive Classroom resource
- \* Primary 1 Literacy Hour
- \* Use of WLC / RIC Attendance resources to improve whole school approach to improving attendance

### How will we use the money to close the poverty related attainment gap?

- \* Family Link Worker to support children and their families, as well as help us to improve attendance
- \* Pupil Support Workers have been employed to support our Nurture Class / Small Group Setting, provide after school clubs and deliver targeted interventions
- \* Literacy Pedagogy Officer will support staff with targeted and universal interventions

### Participatory Budget (PB)

Our learners, parents / carers and staff are consulted about how to spend the PB part of our PEF budget which totals £2300
