What is PEF?

Pupil Equity Funding is a sum of money designated to support children who experience barriers to learning. The Scottish Government requires us to use the fund to close the 'poverty related attainment gap'.

How much PEF money do we receive at St. Mary's PS?

Our allocation is currently £76,680 per year.

Other Key Activities to Assist a Culture of Equity:

- * Participation in WLC Leading Equitable Schools programme
- * Participation in Inclusion Support Model intervention and use of Circle / Inclusive Classroom resource
 - Universal interventions in Literacy in P1 & 2
 - Targeted interventions across the school supported by our SMART target system
- * Use of WLC Attendance resources to improve whole school approach to improving attendance

How will we use the money to close the poverty related attainment gap?

- * Family Link Worker to support children and their families, as well as help us to improve attendance
- * Pupil Support Workers have been employed to support our Nurture Class / Small Group Setting, provide after school clubs and deliver targeted interventions
